## Weekly Club Guide

### Lesson 1: "[God is Creator](#)" (click to view)

**Main Idea:** Our powerful God created the universe, the earth, and everything in it. God created you with purpose and wants a unique relationship with you.

**Key Verse:** "You are worthy, O LORD, to receive glory and honor and power: for You have created all things, and for Your pleasure they exist and were created."  
**Revelation 4:11**

### Ask These Questions:

1. **Is there anything on earth that God didn't make?** (No, God made everything. Even the things people make, like technology and buildings, are made using things that God made first!)
2. **What does that mean about God's role in creation?** (Since God is the creator, He gets to decide what to do with everything! He picks our purpose, He takes care of us, and He decides what's right and wrong.)
3. **What makes people different from the rest of creation?** (People are made in God's image. They reflect God's personality and value in a unique way. We are designed for a friendship with God that nothing else in creation can have.)
4. **What did John 14:6 tell us about how to begin a friendship with God?** (Jesus is the only way to have friendship with God. Relationship with God is impossible without Jesus. But once we understand that Jesus is the creator God and choose to follow Him, our friendship with God is never-ending.)

### Try This Activity:

Have your T&T clubber(s) **come up with an invention**. It can be anything from a robot to a kangaroo-washing machine. They can draw it if they'd like! Have them **describe its purpose and its parts**: name it, say what it's supposed to do, and list the supplies he/she would need to build it. Then, **ask** if it would work the same if they swapped the metal for mud, or if they left out a crucial part. **Remind them** that when God created them, He **designed them perfectly to fulfill their specific purpose**: To love Him, serve Him, and tell others about Him. Everything else they do fits in that **most-important** design!
